Yardage required for jacket (amount for lining is the same):

Yardage required for contrasting collar and lapel:

Yardage required for embellishment as shown on pattern cover:

1/2" tape or soutache trim: 4 yards; 1/4" tape or soutache trim: 4 yards; thin cord trim: 5 yards.

Fabric suggestions: Wool, wool blends, gabardine, other medium- to heavy-weight suiting materials.

Notions: Thread; four to eight large, flat hooks and bars for front closure.

Notes: If you wish, you can also embroider the embellishments onto the jacket. The original vintage jacket from which this pattern was taken featured twill tape and cord trim sewn in place by hand.

5/8" seam allowed on all seams.
