## Fabric suggestions:

Rayon, silk, fine cottons and linens, sheers (overskirt and bodice), and any fabric with a good drape. Heavy, stiff fabrics are not recommended. 100% cotton is recommended for the bodice lining.

## Notions:

Thread, 2 snaps, 2 more snaps or large hooks and eyes. For nursing mother option: 4-6 large snaps or skirt hooks and bars; 4 small snaps.

## Notes:

The pattern piece for the skirt back slightly overlaps the skirt front piece. I recommend tracing this pattern piece onto interfacing or pattern paper anyway, preserving all sizes of the original pattern intact.

**IMPORTANT: If you will be modifying the pattern for larger cup sizes, you'll need to add a small amount to the bodice yardage requirement. See Appendix II.**

\* You will want to decide upon your skirt length prior to purchasing material. See instructions.

\*\* The overskirt length is also up to your personal tastes.
